Prof. S.V Uma Maheswara Rao, Chairman of the Academic Council welcomed and introduced all the members of the Academic Council.

The Member Secretary of the Academic Council, Dr. K. Raghu Ram Mohan Reddy, explained the proposed Academic Rules & Regulations to be adopted by the institute, Course structure of all programs & Syllabi of I & II semesters of B.Tech, M.Tech and MBA programmes during which the following points were discussed:

Points discussed and resolved (UG Regulations):

1. Total Marks: Discussed about the marks to be allotted for Theory and Laboratory
Resolution: It is resolved that the total marks of 100 should be divided as 30 Marks for internal and 70 Marks for external, for both theory and laboratory.
2. CIE Marks: Discussed the criteria of final marks for Continuous Internal Evaluation Marks - presented
Resolution: It is resolved that Final Continuous Internal Evaluation Marks CIE = (Best of (CIE I/CIE II) marks x 0.8 + Least of (CIE I/CIE II) marks x 0.2).
3. SEE marks pattern: Discussed the paper setting pattern for SEE
Resolution: The semester end examinations for 70 marks consist of five questions carrying 14 marks each. "either" "or" choice model
4. Minimum Attendance Requirements: Discussed the minimum attendance requirements to appear for SEE.
Resolution: It has resolved and corrected one of the points as per APSCH as -"A stipulated fee shall be payable towards condonation of shortage of attendance to the college. A student is eligible to write the SEE if he acquires a minimum of 40% in each course and 75% of attendance in aggregate of all the courses"
5. Repeat Continuous Evaluation: Discussed "Repeat Continuous Evaluation" system.
Resolution: Panel members not suggested implementing "Repeat Continuous Evaluation". Action taken.
6. Betterment Examination: Discussed "Betterment Examination" to conduct immediately after completion of the program of study.
Resolution: Panel members not suggested implementing "Betterment Examination". Action taken.
7. Internships: Discussed thoroughly on conducting the summer internship-I after II-year of study.
Resolution: Few members opined that Summer Internship after II- year of study may not be appropriate since the students may not be knowledgeable by the time, However it has been resolved that the time being "No changes suggested", It can be further discussed in next Academic Council.
8. External Project Evaluation Committee: Discussed "External Project Evaluation Committee" composition.
Resolution: It has resolved that the HOD role can be exempted in the External Project Evaluation Committee to finalize the marks. Action taken.
9. Revaluation: Discussed the Revaluation for theory and practicals.
Resolution: It has resolved that no need of "Revaluation" for theory and practicals since the institute is following double valuation (by External and Internal examiners).
10. Minimum credits for promotion: Discussed about the credits required for Promotion from IV to V semester and from VI to VII semester.

Resolution: Minimum 40% credits to be implemented instead of 50% and 60% credits for promotion to V semester and VII semester. Action taken.

Suggestions:

1. Suggestion: No need to mention about the pending fee.
Resolution- modified accordingly.
2. Suggestion: Coding courses shall be designed and implemented for all the programmes of B.Tech in the rest of the semesters as well to have a continuity in learning.
Resolution: To be discussed in next BOS meeting to implement.
3. Suggestion: Institute shall be focused on Capacity building
Resolution: Being considered.
4. Suggestion: To form "Finance Committee"
Resolution: Formulated as per the guidelines.
5. Suggestion: Replace the designation "Dean Examinations" with "Controller of Examinations".
Resolution: Modified as Controller of Examinations.

As per the above suggestions, resolutions and modified and Approved the B. Tech R20 Regulations

Points discussed and resolved (PG Regulations):

Since the Regulations are on par with JNTUK, Kakinada, no suggestions and modifications.
Hence, Approved the M. Tech R20 Regulations.

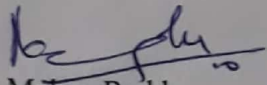
Points discussed and resolved (MBA Regulations):

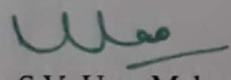
Since the Regulations are on par with JNTUK, Kakinada, no suggestions and modifications.
