Item No. 3: Highlights of NSRIT (Nov. 28, 2020 - Sep. 20, 2021)

Member Secretary presented some of the key highlights of the Institution related to the celebration of Performers Day, Teacher's Day and Engineer's Day as well as the Management incentives for the students and teachers, establishment of Centre for Academic Excellence, Launch of ACM Students' Chapter, Grant of Autonomy, Academic Performance in terms of Success Rate, and other competency development programs pertaining to students and faculty.

Suggestions Made

Based on the above details of the presentation, the members suggested the following items for further action.

- a. To enhance the academic performance in terms of success rate
- To refer Quality Mandate for Higher Education Institutions in India 2021 and enrich all the academic eco-system to promote inter-disciplinary and trans-disciplinary education among stakeholders leveraging the autonomy
- c. To include multiple entry and exit option in line with New Education Folicy 2020
- d. To work towards National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) in the coming years as this is going to earmark the Institution in the future
- e. To introduced Finishing School Programme in the Curriculum to bridge the gap between industry and academia. The Director, NSRIT responded the inputs will be well taken in this regard and updated the members that it is already introduced in the curriculum for few branches and informed that it will be strengthened by taking necessary inputs

- f. To enhance the faculty retention as well as to improve the faculty quality in terms of technical skills and research by enabling them to publish papers in referred journals and submitting quality project proposal to various funding agencies
- g. To connect students and faculty to take project which are more oriented towards society

Item No. 7: Any other Items

The Director, NSRIT requested all the members to approve the Institution to register under Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) which was recently initiated by Ministry of Education (MoE) with an intention of promoting trans-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary education. Members approved the same as requested.
